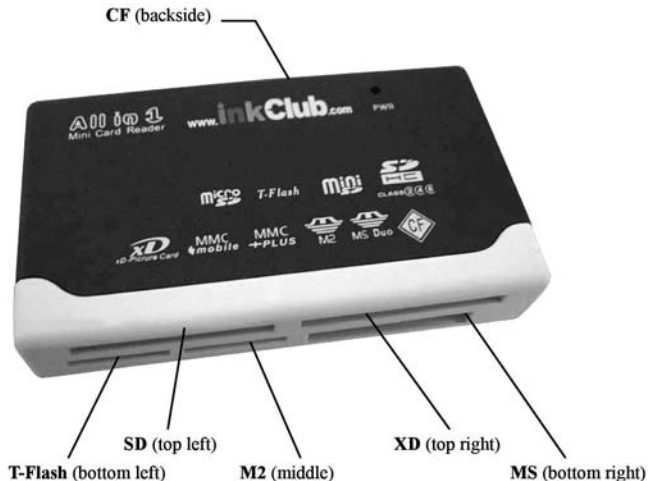


Manual for All in 1 Card Reader

The card reader can be used directly in Windows ME/2000/XP/VISTA. Windows will look for a suitable driver from its database and do the installation as soon as the card reader is connected to the computer.



The six slots support different memory cards as follows:

CF slot	CF I , CF II
XD slot	XD, XD-Type(H)
MS slot	MS, MS PRO, MS Duo, MS Pro-Duo, MS Magic Gate, MS-Pro Magic Gate, HS-MS-Pro Magic Gate, MS-Duo, MS Pro-Duo, MS Pro-Duo PSP, MS Pro-Duo Gaming, HS-MS-Pro Duo, MS-Duo Magic Gate, MS Pro-Duo Magic Gate, M2 (Micro MS)
SD slot	SD, MMC, Mini SD, SD-Ultra, SDC, SMC, RS-MMC, HS-MMC, SDHC.
T-Flash slot	T-Flash (Micro SD)
M2 slot	M2 (Micro MS)

Feature:

There is no need for any adapters when reading Mini SD, T-Flash and M2 card.

Four disks can operate at the same time: CF, XD, MS and SD slots.

Operation:

1. Insert the card into the slot.
2. Connect the card reader to the computer with the USB cable.

Note. The SD, T-Flash and M2 slots are working in the same disk, so the card reader can only read the first inserted card. When it is taken out, the computer will be able to read another card.
